We are recruiting a team of Mental Health Navigators! As part of the Access and Crisis team the M H Navigator will work across several projects within the department to provide a frontline access portal to support clients who currently sit outside of statutory service criteria. Through robust assessments guide the navigation of mental health services for clients presenting with complex needs or in crisis, to access appropriate mental health and social support in order to live well. Including assessing and managing presenting risk to self or others.

The role will require the post holder to develop effective working relationships with both statutory and non-statutory agencies within the local area. To confidently communicate with both clients and professionals to improve client outcomes and promote the service.

You will hold a caseload of clients which will include the delivery of system navigation support, guided self-help, online CBT services, coaching, social prescribing, facilitation of therapeutic groups/courses and taster sessions focussing on early intervention mental health support.
