You will also work closely with the Mental Health Lead within the setting to adapt your service offer and provide Workshops, Courses, Parent engagement and Consultations to support a Whole School Approach to Mental Health.

- Experience of supporting people with low level emotional wellbeing and mental health issues
- Experience of Managing a case load of clients.
- A recognised Counselling or therapy qualification to a minimum of level 4
